Special City Council Meeting Minutes July 31, 2018

City of Council Grove Budget - Public Hearing

Mayor Debi Schwerdtfeger opened the 2019 Budget Hearing.

Councilperson Mark Brooks suggested putting monies into a Capital Outlay for future repairs on the Swimming Pool. Councilperson Jesse Knight noted the 1% Fund needs to be reallocated to show 50% for Infrastructure, 25% to Grants, and 25% Recreation. The Councilmembers requested more information on where the bond payments were coming from. Councilperson Jeff Blosser suggested to add a line in the .7% Fund for Swimming Pool Projects and allocate \$20,000.00 from the City Capital Projects Line to the Swimming Pool Projects Line. Councilperson Jeff Blosser suggested looking into refinancing the bonds/loans for a lower interest rate. Councilperson Jeff Blosser noted the General Fund Salaries need to be reallocated to have salaries budgeted for the City Lake. After further discussion Councilperson Jesse Knight made a motion to close the 2019 Budget Hearing. Councilperson Jeff Blosser seconded the motion and the Council voted 6-0 in favor. Motion carried.
