

ORDINANCE NO. 2190

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS AND HOUSES TO DISPLAY STREET ADDRESS NUMBERS AND SETTING THE PENALTY FOR FAILURE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COUNCIL GROVE, KANSAS:


Section 1. NUMBERS DISPLAYED. All commercial buildings and residences now existing or hereafter erected which front any street or ally shall display the address number applicable to such commercial building or house. The numbers shall be not less than 3 inches in height, shall be clearly legible and shall be conspicuously placed on the front on each commercial building or house. Cursive lettering is not considered to be compliant with the requirements of this section.

Section 2. PENALTY. Failure to comply with Section 1 of this ordinance, after being given a 30 day courtesy notice, shall result in a fine of \$25.00 on the first conviction, \$50.00 on a second conviction, \$100.00 on a third conviction and \$200.00 on a fourth or subsequent conviction.

Section 3. REPEAL. This ordinance repeals Section 14-308 of Ordinance No. 1820 of the ordinances of the City of Council Grove, Kansas.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effect upon its publication in the official city newspaper.
