PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Angie Schwerdtfeger representing Pride ask the Council to allow the Farmers Market to block off parking spaces on S Mission Street. After discussion the Council approved allowing signs to be posted the day of the Farmers Market that read no parking starting at 2pm. ORDINANCE NO. 1992

AN ORDINANCE SETTING RATES AND POLICIES WITH REGARD TO WATER DEPOSITS BEFORE CONNECTION WITH THE CITY WATER SYSTEM

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COUNCIL GROVE, KANSAS:

Section 1. WATER DEPOSIT. Before any consumer shall be connected with the water system, he or she shall sign an application or contract for service on forms furnished by the city and shall deposit with the city clerk, in the case of domestic consumers, the sum of \$60.00 or in the case of commercial/industrial consumers, such deposit may be determined by the superintendent of the water works which amount will not be less than the amount of the estimated bill for two months usage of water. The water superintendent may, at any time, require an increase in the deposit made by any residential, commercial or industrial consumer. The amount of any unpaid water bill shall be deducted from the deposit and the unused portion returned to the consumer upon termination of service.

Section 2. <u>RECONNECTION</u>. Should any person who formerly had service, request reconnection to the city water system, any outstanding account to the city for such prior service shall be paid in full prior to reconnection.

Section 3. <u>REPEAL</u>. Section 16-125 of Ordinance 1820 of the ordinances of the City of Council Grove is hereby repealed.

Section 4. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This ordinance shall be effective upon it's publication in the Louncil Grove Republican.

12-663. Installation of slides, diving boards and similar structures.

- (a) PERMIT REQUIRED. No persons shall construct or install any slide, water slide, diving board, or any other similar structure at the Council Grove Lake Park without first having a permit for the approval of such construction and installation from the governing body of the City of Council Grove, Kansas.
- (b) PENALTY. Any person violating this section shall be required to remove any such improvement or structure and shall also be subject to a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$1,000.00.







ASSEMBLED ROGUE2 LAYOUT





MANUFACTURER'S PLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

THE SLIDE OWNER MUST REVIEW THE MANUFACTURER'S PLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS WITH THE INSTALLER TO ENSURE THAT THE MANUFACTURER'S INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN MET.

PROPER ASSEMBLY, INSTALLATION, USE AND SUPERVISION IS ESSENTIAL FOR PROPER OPERATION AND TO REDUCE THE RISK OF SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH.

- 1. The critical dimensions for placement of the heliXTM are as shown in FIGURES 2 and 3.
 - A. The slide exit runway surface shall not exceed 20" (508 mm) above the water surface as shown in FIGURE 2.
 - B. The slide shall be positioned so that all water flowing off the runway exit drops into the pool. Recommended overhang is 4" (102 mm).
 - C. The minimum depth of water below the exit lip of the slide shall be 3' (914 mm) and increases to 4'-6" (1372 mm) at Pt. A, which is a distance of 4'-6" (1372 mm) from the exit lip of the slide as shown in FIGURE 2.
 - D. A minimum depth of 4'-6" (1372 mm) shall be maintained at a distance of 9' (2743 mm) along the extended centerline of the slide from Pt. A. as shown in FIGURE 2.



