Mark Brooks, Administrator for the Kaw Mission and Last Chance Store requested the city enter into a verbal agreement with the State Historical Society to clear snow in the parking lot of the Kaw Mission site. NEW BUSINESS

- **City Lake Plat Proposal – Kaw Valley Engineering:**
Jason Loader and Chris Sodorlin with Kaw Valley Engineering presented a proposal for scope of service to plat the roads and create easements at the City Lake. City City Administrator Nick Jones said that currently the roads are considered trails sense they don't meet the state standards if 40 foot wide, which can cause access issues for the homeowners if the city were to ever sell the lease holds. Mr. Loader and Mr. Sodorlin said that the surveying would be done by drone and would take approximately 3 days to complete. They would then need to adjust lines for easements and utilities and allow for a minimum of 40ft wide for the roadways. The cost to plat the roads and easements is approximately \$39,940, which would come out of the lake improvement fund. After discussion Councilperson Jason Booker made a motion to approve the proposal in the amount of \$39,940. The motion was seconded by Councilperson Sharon Haun. Motion Carried 6 – 0
